ARIDE is a 16-hour course offering additional information on detecting impairment caused by more than just alcohol. Officers will be able to identify drug impairment characteristics in an impaired driver. Officers will be more proficient with the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN), Walk and Turn (WAT), and One Leg Stand (OLS) tests and gain a broader knowledge of drug impairment indicators. The officer will also be more familiar with the Drug Evaluation and Classification (DEC) Program and its function. This will facilitate better communication and transfer of critical roadside indicators of impairment to the evaluating Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) for a more complete and accurate assessment of the impairment
